ACTIVE INGREDIENT: Contains Polyvinyl Polymers dispersed in oil solvents.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, DO NOT induce vomiting. Give nothing by mouth. Take to hospital without delay. If skin contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas of skin. DO NOT scrub the skin. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If concentrate is splashed in eyes, hold lids open and flush with water for 15 minutes. Take to hospital immediately. Ensure adequate ventilation when handling the concentrate. Remove protective clothing and wash hands and face thoroughly before meals and after work. Wash protective clothing daily after work. Do not eat, drink or smoke while using this product.

DISPOSAL: When empty triple rinse container and add residue to spray tank. Dispose of this product only by using according to the label, or at an approved landfill, or other approved facility. Avoid contamination of any water supply or stream with product or empty container.

STORAGE: Store in original container out of reach of children.

SHELF LIFE: When stored appropriately this product should show no significant degradation for 2 years from date of manufacture. Contact your supplier for further information about the use of any product that is older than this.

SITUATION	RATE	DIRECTIONS
Ground Boom application	30-60 ml Lo-Drift* per 100 litres spray solution	Use lowest rate of Lo-Drift* first as a trial. A small amount of Lo-Drift* may cause large changes in pesticide sprays
Gun Application	45 - 90 ml Lo-Drift* per 100 litre spray solution	The increased amount of Lo-Drift* gives greater drift control at higher pressures
Aerial Spraying	30 ml Lo-Drift* per 100 litres spray solution	For best coverage apply in two parallel passes, each applying half the total spray volume as a part overlap

LO-DRIFT concentrate is slippery and difficult to wash or wipe off hands and containers, so care should be taken when handling concentrate to avoid spillage.
