ACTIVE INGREDIENT: Contains 360g/litre glyphosate as the isopropylamine salt in the form of a water soluble concentrate.

WARNING: May cause skin and eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes and skin.

FIRST AID: If swallowed DO NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately. If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. DO NOT scrub the skin. If splashed in eyes, wash out immediately with water for at least 15 minutes. If inhaled move the victim to fresh air immediately. Begin artificial respiration if breathing has stopped.

PERSONAL PROTECTION: Avoid contact with skin or inhalation of spray mist. Gloves should be worn at all times. Wear eye protection when handling the concentrate. Ensure adequate ventilation when handling the concentrate. Remove protective clothing and wash hands and face thoroughly before meals and after work. Wash protective clothing daily after work. Do not eat, drink or smoke while using this product.

STORAGE: Store in original container, away from foodstuffs in a cool, dry area.

SHELF LIFE: When stored appropriately, this product should show no significant degradation for 2 years from the date of manufacture. Contact your supplier for further information about the use of any product that is older than this.

DISPOSAL: Triple rinse container and add residue to work tank. Dispose of container at an approved landfill or other approved facility.

ECOTOXIC: Toxic to aquatic organisms (Algae) with long-lasting effects. Avoid contamination of any water supply with chemical or empty container.

DO NOT apply under weather conditions or spraying conditions which would be expected to cause spray to drift onto nearby crops and susceptible plants.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- **Samurai™**, when used as directed, controls annual weeds and hard to kill perennial weeds such as couch, paspalum, kikuyu grass and California thistle.
- **Samurai™** is absorbed by plant foliage and green stems, and is translocated through the plant from point of contact into the root system.
- **Samurai™** may not show obvious results for up to 7-14 days depending on weather conditions, weed species and the herbicide use rate. Rainfall occurring up to 2 hours after application may reduce effectiveness. A second treatment may be necessary.
- **Samurai™** will control emerged weeds only, and provides no residual control.
- **Samurai™** can be applied at any time to annual weeds which are actively growing. For perennial weeds best results are obtained when there is 15cm or more of top growth.

WITHHOLDING PERIOD: There is no withholding period for **Samurai™** except ragwort. However it is recommended to avoid grazing or cultivating weeds after spraying for 3 days if treating annual weeds or 7-10 days if treating perennial weeds, to allow translocation of this product through the root system.

COMPATIBILITY: **Samurai™** is compatible with commonly used herbicides.
