BRUSHWEEDS	GUN ml/100L	AERIAL litres/ha		
Blackberry	300-600	10	Apply during summer and autumn when bushes are in active growth. Some Northland and East Coast areas may contain difficult to kill species. If these species are present, variable results may occur.	
Broom	200-300	10	Best results are obtained from early spring to summer when plants are in full leaf.	
Gorse	200-300	10	Applications should be made to actively growing plants (Nov - May) with thorough coverage essential for best results. Do not apply if plants are under stress from either extreme heat or cold. Use the higher rate from Feb - May. The addition of an organo silicone surfactant will increase the level of gorse control and minimise the variability.	
Lupin	150	3	Apply to actively growing plants.	
Tree Tutu	300	8	Apply to fresh regrowth and after frond expansion.	
Fennel	300	-	Apply to actively growing plants.	
Sweet Brier	500	-	Apply from expanded leaf emergence to early leaf yellowing, ensuring full coverage of stems and crown.	
Old Mans Beard	400	-	Apply Nov - March when plants are in full leaf. Do not apply after leaf senescence. Very large vines should be cut at ground level in winter and the regrowth sprayed in March.	
BROADLEAF WEEDS IN TURF - Hydrocotyle, creeping oxalis and some other broadleaf weeds Use 2 litres/ha or 2ml/10m ² . Burning may occur in some fine turf grasses. Do not use clippings from treated areas for compost or mulch for six months after treatment.				
KIKUYU IN TURF Apply 2 litres/ha in autumn when there is sufficient moisture for turf growth. Two additional applications at 4-6 week intervals may be required to achieve control. Do not use clippings from treated areas for compost or mulch for six months after treatment.				
APPLICATION Knapsack: Add 6ml Victory™ / litre of water. Use only on small plants where full coverage of foliage and stems can be achieved. Mistblower: Add 100ml/10 litre tank and ensure good coverage of foliage and stems. For ULV attachments, use the highest setting and add 500ml/10 litre tank. Stump swabbing: Blackberry, hawthorn, woolly nightshade, wattle, willow, gorse & broom. Mix 50ml Victory™ /litre water or diesel and using a paint brush or knapsack, liberally coat freshly cut surface and stems to ground level. If using diesel, agitate while filling and during use. Aerial: Use 200-400 litres water / hectare. Apply with a calibrated aircraft using the half overlap-opposite pass technique. Aerial applications will usually require some follow up ground treatment.				

GENERAL COMMENTS:

- 1 For the most effective results applications should be made during soft active growth (Nov - Feb).
- 1 Spraying when plants are dormant or stressed may give variable results.
- 1 Apply from all directions to achieve full coverage of the foliage and stems. Do not use gun spraying pressures less than 1000 kPa or greater than 2000 kPa.

MIXING:

Pour the correct amount of Victory into the partly filled tank, and while agitating add the remainder of the water.

WARNINGS:

- 1 Drift: Apply this product carefully. Spray drift may cause serious damage to other desirable plants.
- 1 Clovers: Victory will damage clovers at rates recommended for brushweed control.
- 1 Sprayer clean-up: To avoid injury to subsequently sprayed crops, thoroughly remove all traces of Victory from mixing and spray equipment. Thoroughly clean all sprayer parts with several flushes of clean water.
